



FOSSILS AND FUEL

Our adventure begins with a step back in time. We'll visit the *George Page Museum*, where you'll get up close and personal with all of the creatures that have been excavated from the *La Brea Tar Pits* since 1913 when the fabulous fossils were found. *Rancho La Brea* has been one of the world's most famous fossil localities, recognized for having the largest and most diverse assemblage of extinct Ice Age plants and animals in the world. We will learn about Los Angeles as it was between 10,000 and 40,000 years ago, during the last Ice Age, when animals such as saber-toothed cats and mammoths roamed the Los Angeles Basin. Outside the Museum, in *Hancock Park*, life-size replicas of several extinct mammals are featured. Afterwards, let's venture over to the *Farmers Market* to fuel up our bodies for lunch on your own. Now, we're all rev-ed up for our last stop of the day - the *Petersen Automotive Museum*. On your docent led tour, you'll experience the past 100 years of history at this \$40 million museum, which is dedicated to the exploration and presentation of the automobile.
