High atop a hill on 110 acres amongst the Santa Monica Mountains and overlooking Los Angeles is the Getty Center - still as incredible as it was the day it opened 25 years ago. The \$1.3 billion Getty Center presents the Getty's collection of Western art from the Middle Ages to the present - against a backdrop of dramatic architecture, tranquil gardens, and breathtaking views from downtown L.A. to the ocean. Enjoy approximately four hours at leisure exploring the galleries and gardens. Enjoy lunch on your own at the Getty's café or restaurant. In addition to the Getty's fine permanent collection of European and American art, scheduled to be on display is the special exhibit, "A Passion for Collecting Manuscripts." The Getty Museum is one of the few museums in the United States that maintains and displays a collection of medieval illuminated manuscripts. Portable and sumptuous, these hand-crafted treasures have garnered the interest of collectors throughout the centuries. Each has a unique story, and clues in the books themselves often provide tantalizing evidence that help reconstruct their meanderings through time. This exhibition shares intriguing stories about our manuscripts and the remarkable journeys that brought them to Los Angeles.
